ICE AGE IN SCOTLAND

- Before 12000 years, british isles were covered by glaciations
- Parts of Scotland were destroyed

AFTER ICE AGE

- After the ice age ends, the repupolation of Scotland started
- At this time, Scotland was covered by forests, and only little hunter villages existed

FIRST CIVILIZATIONS

• First villages were built ~6000 years ago

THE ROMANS

- First Roman incursion at 79 AD (in german: nach Christus)
- Retreet of Romans at 400 AD

MIDDLE AGE

- Beginning sixth century, Scotland was divided in three areas: Pictland, Anglosaxon kingdom of Northrumbia, Dál Riata
- In 14th century, the Stuarts boarded the throne of Scotland

MODERN TIME

- Since 1997 scotland wants to be independent from Great Britain
- At 1603 Jakob II boarded the throne of Scotland
- 1707 Scotland joined United Kingdom
- 1999 scotland got an own parlament

FAMOUS SCOTTISH CITIES AND THEIR FOUNDATIONS

- Edinburgh (Capitol of Scotland): 1st century BC
- Glasgow: 80 AD
- Dundee: 1191 AD
- Aberdeen: 12th Century AD
- Dunfermline: 1070 AD
